





New Students With Disabilities (All Grades) Certificate Created

At its September 2022 meeting, the New York State Board of Regents <u>voted to establish</u> the Students with Disabilities (All Grades) certificate effective September 28, 2022. The new certificate permits individuals to teach students with disabilities in pre-Kindergarten through grade 12 in New York State public schools. The Board of Regents also approved revisions to the <u>extension</u> to teach certain subjects to students with disabilities in grades 5-9 or grades 7-12 for eligible special education teachers.

The key changes to the regulations, and the implementation timeline for the changes, are described below and in the <u>presentation</u> to the Board of Regents. For additional information about the SWD (All Grades) certificate, please see the <u>SWD (All Grades) Certificate Summary and Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)</u>.





Substitute Teaching:

For the 2023-2024 school year and beyond, SED will continue its policy of allowing uncertified individuals to substitute teach beyond the 40-day maximum up to 90 days in a school year in situations where the district or BOCES certifies that it has conducted a good faith recruitment search for a qualified candidate yet could not find a certified teacher for the position. In rare circumstances, districts/BOCES can extend beyond the 90-day period if a superintendent attests to another good faith recruitment search that failed to identify a certified teacher and that a particular substitute is needed until the end of the school year.

Substitute Teaching (OTI:NYSED)





Re-Issuance of Initial Certificates:

As of August 2, 2023, teachers and school leaders can apply for two (2) 5-year Reissuances of their initial certificates. The state had previously removed the CTLE hours' requirement for a reissuance and this latest change has also removed the requirement for the applicant to retake the Content Specialty Test.

The requirements for the first reissuance are that the applicant has met all the requirements for the professional EXCEPT the education (master's degree) and/or the experience requirement. Members apply on TEACH and submit an Attestation form to the state at tect@nyssed.gov.

The requirements for the second reissuance are that the applicant has met all the requirements for the professional EXCEPT the education (master's degree) OR the experience requirement.





Educator Permit for Military Personnel:

In response to federal law that require a receiving state to consider the professional license or educator certificate of a servicemember or their spouse to be valid in the new jurisdiction for the duration of a military order or orders, SED has created an Emergency Permit for eligible servicemembers.

Full-time teachers employed under the Educator Permit are subject to Part 30 rules regarding appointments and tenure and current education law regarding annual evaluations. If employed for five or more years under an Emergency Permit, the teacher must complete CTLE requirements.

SED is currently creating the application in TEACH and expect it to be available to servicemembers and their spouses by the end of August 2023.





Currently certified teachers can obtain a supplementary certificate by completing 9 or 12 credits in the certificate title sought, passing of the Content Specialty Test, and receiving a commitment of employment from the district. The teacher would then have 5 additional years to complete any missing requirements for the new certificate.

In response to a recent influx of English language learners, SED has changed the requirements for the supplementary certificate for (a) certified teachers applying for a supplementary certificate in ESOL and (b) certified ESOL teachers applying for a supplementary certificate in another area. For the period between September 12, 2023, and August 31, 2024, the requirements will be completion of either the exam requirement or the course requirements (from appropriate Test out




SED is also changing the requirements for the Supplementary Bilingual Education extension. For the period between September 12, 2023, and August 31, 2024, certified teachers and pupil personnel services professionals can obtain this credential by passing the Bilingual Education Assessment (BEA) in lieu of completing required coursework. This credential is valid only for three years.

Program Service Code 0231— ELL Eligible

All students with an ELL eligible record at any time during the school year will be included in the ELL group for accountability purposes. All ELL eligible students must be provided ELL services.

The ELL Program Service Codes for identifying the type of services received are: 5709 (English as a New Language (ENL) 5676 (Transitional Bilingual Education (TBE) Program) 5687 (One Way or Two Way Dual Language Program), or 8239 (ELL Eligible but not in an ELL Program).

Students can be in only one ELL program (i.e., Program Service Codes 5709, 5676, 5687, or 8239) at a time but may participate in more than one during the school year. One record must be provided for each ELL program in which a student participated. The record must indicate the dates of participation.

ELL Eligible Student Service Levels: LEAs must identify the level of service an ELL eligible student (Code 0231) is receiving. The Units of Study tables provided are guidelines for mandated services for ELLs as per Commissioner's Regulations Part 154-2 in both English as a New Language and Bilingual Education programs. Beginning in the Fall of 2021, and occurring each year, public schools and BOCES report data on students' access to devices and broadband in their places of residence to the New York State Education Department's Student Information and Repository System (SIRS). This information will replace the Technology questions 8B and 8D currently collected as part of the Basic Education Data System (BEDS) Institutional Master File (IMF).

This collection will help identify specific needs and target resources and funding opportunities when they become available. It is for this reason that NYSED strongly recommends that the student digital resources data elements are entered into SIRS as soon as possible during the school year. It is expected that public school districts, BOCES, and charter schools will conduct the survey in the fall of each year.

Utilizing the eScholar Student Digital Resources template, there would be at a minimum, one record for each student grades K-12 (including ungraded elementary and secondary students). If a student remains in one building, schools are encouraged to update information as is possibly feasible. For example, a student may not have had access to Wi-Fi earlier in the year, but now does.

When a student is enrolled in a new location (a second school building), a new record would be reported with that building information. The new school should review the information and update as needed.

Beginning in May 2022, LEAs are able to report partial survey results to SIRS. A survey date and a minimum of one survey question will be required. All fields will continue to be edited for valid data.







Student enrollment counts from SIRS (Student Information Repository System) are calculated for public schools and districts, and for charter schools. Nonpublic schools, including Article 81 schools, will not see BEDS (Basic Education Data System) enrollment verification reports in L2RPT (Level 2 Reporting) at this time. These enrollment counts are used for many purposes including: State aid calculations, generating targeted federal program aid, Limited English Proficient (LEP) student counts for Part 154, reporting in New York State Report Cards and to the media and public upon request, and Universal Pre-K (UPK) grant allocations.

Student enrollment counts are calculated from SIRS as of BEDS Day each year. BEDS Day is the first Wednesday in October because it is expected that by this date in the school year, returning and new student registrations have been processed and stable enrollment counts can be obtained. BEDS Day provides a point in time when student enrollment counts can be complete, unduplicated, and comparable.

BEDS enrollment is determined solely based on enrollment and the consequent expectation of attendance in a specific school or district. Though the district of reporting responsibility and the district of residence usually correlate highly with the school or district of enrollment, they do not directly determine the BEDS enrollment. Students may be the reporting responsibility of one district but enrolled in another; likewise, students may be residents of one district but enrolled in another. If a student is enrolled in a specific school, the student is counted as part of the BEDS enrollment, regardless of any other qualifying or disqualifying factors, such as where the student lives and other demographic or program service considerations.

Students reported in SIRS with any of the following Reason for Beginning Enrollment codes are included in the BEDS enrollment count:

- 0011 (Enrollment in building or grade)
- 0022 (Foreign Exchange Student) (with exception of SIRS-312)
- 5544 (Transferred under ESEA [Elementary and Secondary Education Act] Title 1, School in Improvement Status)
- 7000 (Transferred under ESEA, Persistently Dangerous School)
 - 7011 (Transferred under ESEA, Victim of a Serious Violent Incident)

Information on an Appeal to Graduate with a Lower Score on a Regents Examination

General Information

Beginning with students entering grade 9 in 2005, all students who have taken and passed certain courses in preparation to take a Regents examination and have a 65 course average but whose highest score on the Regents examination is below but within <u>five</u> points of the 65 passing score (60-64) may appeal to graduate with a local or Regents diploma using this lower score. Students who are granted one appeal from their local school district under this provision shall earn a Regents diploma. Students who are granted two appeals under this provision shall earn a local diploma. Through this appeal, the student seeks a waiver of the graduation assessment requirement in this subject area.
