THE DIGITAL EQUITY TASK FORCE

The ConnectALL Office, in partnership with the New York State Library, has launched a Digital Equity Taskforce. The Taskforce will help guide the State in its plan for over \$1B of investments through the State Digital Equity Plan and Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program through input on:

- Vision for achieving digital equity across the state
- Barriers and assets to digital equity
- Specific needs of historically marginalized populations, including incarcerated people, aging people, low-income people, veterans, individuals with disabilities, individuals with a language barrier, members of racial or ethnic minority groups, and rural residents.

Representatives from over a dozen State Agencies will be working with community leaders to launch a series of public meetings focused on Education, Healthcare, Workforce and Economic Development, Civic and Social Engagement, and the Accessibility of Government Services.
