Career and Technical Education (CTE) Students


CTE Programs: Located in high schools and BOCES, Career and Technical Education programming provides academic and technical instruction in the content areas of agriculture, business and marketing, family and consumer sciences, health sciences, trade and technical education, and/or technology education. CTE programs are comprised of at least three CTE courses (equivalent to three full units of study) and incorporate the Career Development and Occupational Studies (CDOS) Learning Standards. A list of CTE program service codes is found in Chapter 5: Codes and Descriptions. CTE programs that are sequences used to fulfill diploma requirements also include the content of the one-half unit state-developed Career and Financial Management curricular framework. Programs used to fulfil diploma requirements must first be approved by the Office of Career and Technical Education. See the Program Approval Process and Approved CTE Programs for additional information.


