OPEN – Level 0 is now open for the 2023-2024 SY

Level 0 is now accepting data for the 2023 – 2024 school year. ESBOCES recently loaded initial ATS Enrollment data to LO; Program Fact information for ELL and ESEA grant reporting is not yet available.

High Schools with August Grads: ANY student that received a graduation credential in August that included CTE, CDOS, Seal of Biliteracy, or Seal of Civic Readiness must have a Program Fact records for that program added in LO ASAP.

2023-2024 SIRS Annual Memo and Timeline

NYSED released the Annual Student Information and Reporting System, SIRS, Memo and Timeline. ESBOCES is creating an annotated version of the Timeline to help your school plan and provide some clarity on the different systems used for various data types that are collected by the NYCDOE, ESBOCES or reported directly to NYSED. PLEASE BE AWARE that the deadlines listed here are for the NYCDOE to post data to SED. *Charter schools will have earlier deadlines for reporting data to the DOE and ESBOCES*.

2022-2023 SIRS End of Year Statement of Certification

NYSED has announced that the EOY certification statement will continue to be available after the <u>September 1, deadline</u>. The CEO of each school must log into NYSED's <u>Business Portal</u> and open the IDEX application to complete this form. View the full email announcement <u>here</u>.

Accessing NYSED systems is managed by the CEO

ONLY your school CEO or a Delegated Administrator can authorize anyone to access L2RPT, the Business Portal, or any other NYSED system. ESBOCES, NYCDOE (Charter Schools Office), and NYSED cannot create or manage access to those data systems.

Each school superintendent/CEO, as listed in <u>SEDREF</u>, was given administrative access by default to the SED Delegated Account Systems (SEDDAS). Access to SEDDAS is available within the <u>NYSED Application</u> <u>Business Portal - Dashboard</u> (must be logged in). Only the CEO, or delegate, can provide access to any SED system for their school to another person. Access will be instantaneous once you are given these permissions. Note that the NYSED Application Business Portal and access to L2RPT, <u>IBM Cognos Analytics</u>, utilize the same credentials. If your current Superintendent/CEO is not listed in SEDREF, you may update that information by accessing the following link: <u>SEDREF Update Process</u>. NYSED maintains a contact file of staff in certain positions at every school in the SED Reference File (SEDREF). It is important to keep this up-to-date in order for your school to receive important notices from NYSED.

<u>IMPORTANT</u> SEDREF title for data Coordinators: The Office of Information and Reporting Services (IRS) will also continue to utilize the Chief Information Officer (CIO) identified in SEDREF for all notifications related to SIRS reporting. SED periodically posts data to the IRS Portal, IRSP, email announcements of such postings are ONLY sent to SEDREF CIO listings. It is important to ensure that the CIO field is also kept up-to-date.
